India on way to becoming self-reliant nation: Prez

New Delhi, 14 August

President Droupadi Murmu on Thursday said India is well on the way to becoming a self-reliant nation and moving ahead with great confidence to be a developed economy by 2047.

In her address to the nation on the eve of the 79th Independence Day, Murmu said the country's economy is in the pink of health with inflation under control, and exports rising. "After the long years of foreign rule, India was in utter poverty at the time of Independence. But in the 78 years since then, we have made extraordinary progress in all fields. India is well on the way to becoming a self-reliant nation and is moving ahead with great confidence," the President said.

In the economic field, she said India's achievements are more noticeable with GDP growing at 6.5 per cent in the last fiscal, making the country the fastest growing among the major economies in the world.

"Even amid stress in the global economy, demand at home is pacing ahead. Inflation has remained under control. Exports are rising. All key indicators show the economy in the pink of health," Murmu said.

She attributed the achievements on the economic front to the carefully calibrated reforms, sagacious economic management, hard work, and dedication of farmers.

"The all-round economic growth complemented by social sector initiatives has placed India well on the path of becoming a developed nation by 2047. With the nation marching ahead during the Amrit

Kaal, I see all of us contributing to the best of our ability," she said.

Observing that a large number of people have been pulled out of poverty through good governance, the President said the government has been running a series of welfare initiatives for the poor and also for those who have risen above the poverty line, but are still vulnerable.

"Income inequality is reducing. Regional disparities are also disappearing," Murmu said, adding that states and regions known for weaker economic performance are now showing their true potential and catching up with front-runners.

Stressing that business leaders, small

16 BSF personnel get gallantry medals for Op Sindoor

Sixteen Border Security Force (BSF) personnel have been awarded gallantry medals for displaying "conspicuous bravery" and "unmatched valour" during Operation Sindoor against Pakistan. The gallantry medals for these troops, some of whom destroyed enemy surveillance cameras while others neutralised drone attacks, were announced by the Union government on the eve of the 79th Independence Day.

"This Independence Day, 16 Brave Seema Praharis are being awarded Gallantry Medals for their conspicuous bravery & unmatched valour, for being resolute & steadfast during the Op Sindoor. The medals are a testament to the nation's faith & trust reposed in India's First Line of Defence: The Border Security Force," the BSF said in a social media post.

Publish list of voters deleted in Bihar SIR before Aug 19: SC to EC

The Supreme Court on Thursday directed the Election Commission of India (ECI) to publish on its website before August 19 the names of those who have been excluded from the draft electoral roll after the special internet revision (SIR) exercise in Bihar.

The reasons for the omission of approximately 6.5 million voters must be given, and their names should be searchable online based on EPIC (Elector Photo Identity Card) numbers, the top court said. Soft copies of the deleted voters list must be available on the respective district electoral office websites, the court added.

"The list of 6.5 million voters, whose names appeared in the 2025 list but are not included in the draft list, shall be displayed on the websites of district electoral officers. The information would be booth-wise but it can be accessed by referring to EPIC number. The lists shall be published on the website of the Chief Electoral Officer, Bihar," the court directed. The apex court also told the ECI to accept Aadhaar card as a document for establishing identity.

"Your list of 11 documents seems citizen-friendly, but Aadhaar and EPIC are readily available. The reason we can say that those who have not submitted so far, can submit their Aadhaar and EPIC also," said Justice Joydeep Chatterjee of the top court Bench that is hearing the matter. The Bench of Justice Surya Kant and Justice Bagchi is hearing a clutch of petitions challenging the ECI's June 24 directive, ordering SIR of Bihar electoral roll. The directive requires voters not

listed in the 2003 electoral roll to submit documents proving their citizenship. Those born after December 2004 must also furnish citizenship documents of both parents, with additional requirements if a parent is a foreign national. Apart from the directions above, the bench also ordered the ECI to publicise the deleted voters list through newspapers, electronic media, and social media. Printed booth-wise lists of deleted voters along with reasons for their deletion must also be displayed at panchayat and block development offices, the court directed.

"For a migrant worker who has been deleted as dead, even if he is illiterate, his neighbours or friends would alert him... it is only fair to have a procedure that does not block a person from exercising his right to adult franchise. There are civil consequences involved," Justice Kant told Senior Advocate Rakesh Dwivedi, who is appearing for the ECI.

States urge Centre to ramp up urea supply

Union agriculture minister Shriyash Chouhan chaired a meeting on Thursday where state agriculture ministers and officials demanded additional urea supplies.

Chouhan asked states to take strict action against hoarders and black marketers, adding that the Centre was already sending enough supplies. He also urged states to accurately map the fertiliser requirement for the upcoming rabi sowing season.

"There could be two main reasons for the increased demand for urea: first, an increase in the sowing of rice, maize, and other crops due to good rainfall; second, possible misuse of urea for non-agricultural purposes," Chouhan said. He added that if the demand was genuinely for farming needs, urea would certainly be supplied. But warned of strict action if there was any suspicion of misuse.

Chouhan urged all state agriculture ministers to ensure optimum use of urea by forming monitoring committees and strengthening oversight mechanisms.

Chouhan said that the next rabi conference would be held on September 15 and September 16 in New Delhi. On the first day of the conference, the officials of the Centre, along with their state government counterparts will chalk out a road map and discuss the availability of seeds, and fertilisers. The Union agriculture minister said that a five-year action plan will be drawn for the agricultural sector, suggestions will be taken from progressive farmers and experts during the next phase of "Viksit Krishi Sankalp Abhiyan" to begin from October 3 after Dussehra. The minister said no permission would be granted for the sale of biostimulants until it was scientifically verified. He also announced that on August 23, Prime Minister Narendra Modi will launch the Natural Agriculture Mission.

Stray dog problem due to authorities' inaction, says SC, reserves order

The Supreme Court on Thursday said the "whole problem" of stray dogs in Delhi NCR was a result of the "inaction" of local authorities which did "nothing" in implementing the Animal Birth Control Rules on sterilisation and immunisation of canines. A bench of Justices Vikram Nath, Sandeep Mehta, and NV Anjaria, which was constituted to hear a suo motu

case and some other pleas concerning stray dogs, reserved its verdict on the interim prayer for a stay on the directions issued by the court on August 11. A two-judge bench on August 11 ordered the Delhi-NCR authorities to permanently relocate strays from streets to dog shelters. The bench had acted in the suo motu case initiated on July 28 over a

media report on stray dogs bites leading to rabies, particularly among children, in the national capital. "The whole problem is because of inaction of the local authorities. You frame rules in Parliament. The government acts, rules are framed but no implementation is carried out creating problem which is standing today," the bench said.

Convince B'desh to let us erect border fencing, Meghalaya tells MHA

The Meghalaya government has asked the Union Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) to convince Bangladesh for permission to erect border fencing closer to the international boundary to secure a 40 km unfenced stretch without leaving villages outside the fenced area. Deputy Chief Minister Prestone Tynsong said. Under international norms, border fencing is built 150 yards inside a country's territory. But in Meghalaya's case, this would result in several villages falling within 'no man's land' or outside the fencing, compromising their safety.

"We have taken up with the MHA, urging it to convince the government of Bangladesh, because of this reality, let us go close to the main pillar of the border so that we can avoid fencing outside the village," Tynsong told PTI. Tynsong, who is also Home minister, held a meeting with top Home department officials on Wednesday to review international border security after the recent infiltration attempt and the subsequent arrests of Bangladesh nationals.

Completely vague: SC on plea to return elephants kept in Vantara

The Supreme Court on Thursday termed as "completely vague" a plea seeking to constitute a monitoring committee to return the "captive elephants" in Vantara, a wildlife rescue and rehabilitation centre for wild animals. A bench of Justices Pankaj Mishra and PB Varale told advocate CR Jaya Sukin, petitioner in person, that he was making allegations against Vantara without even adding them as party. The top court asked the petitioner to implead Vantara in the petition. "You are making allegations against parties which are not represented here. You have not made them respondents. You implead them and then you come to us to say we will do it," the bench said and posted the matter for August 25. The apex court also tagged a similar petition with Sukin's plea. The petition was earlier mentioned before Chief Justice of India B R Gavai for urgent listing. The plea has sought constitution of a monitoring committee to ensure the return of the captive elephants to its owners.
