President Droupadi Murmu on Thursday said India is well on the way to becoming a self-reliant nation and moving ahead with great confidence to be a developed economy by 2047.

In her address to the nation on the eve of the 79th Independence Day, Murmu said the country's economy is in the pink of health with inflation under control, and exports risins. "After the long years of foreign rule, India was in utter poverty at the time of Independence. But in the 78 years since then, we have made extraordinary progress in all fields. India is well on the way to becoming a self-reliant nation and is moving ahead with great confidence," the President said.

In the economic field, she said India's achievements are more noticeable with GDP growing at 6, per cent in the last fis-cal, making the country the fastest growing among the major economics in the world.

"Even amid stress in the global economy, demand at home is pacing ahead. Inflation has remained under control. Exports are rising. All key indicators show the economy in the pink of health," Murmu said.

Publish list of voters States urge deleted in Bihar SIR before Aug 19: SC to EC

The Supreme Court on Thursday di-

The Supreme Court on Thursday directed the Election Commission of India (ECI) to publish on its website before August 19 the names of those who have been excluded from the draft electoral roll after the special intensive revision (SIR) exercise in Bihar.

The reasons for the omission of approximately 6,5 million voters must be given, and their names should be searchable online based on EPIC (Electors Photo Identity Card) numbers, the top court said. Soft copies of the deleted voters list must be available on the respective district electoral officer websites, the court added.

"The list of 6,5 million voters, whose names appeared in the 2025 list but are not included in the draft list, shall be dis-

"The list of 6,5 million voters, whose names appeared in the 2025 list but are not included in the draft list, shall be displayed on the websites of district electoral officers. The information would be booth-wise but it can be accessed by referring to EPC number. The lists shall be published on the website of the Chief Electoral Officer, Bihar," the court directed. The apex court also told the ECI to accept Aadhaar card as a document for establishing identity.

Those born after December 2004 must also furnish citizenship documents of both parents, with additional requirements if a parent is a foreign national. Apart from the directions above, the bench also ordered the ECI to publicise the deleted voters list through newspapers, electronic media, and social media. Printed booth-wise lists of deleted voters along with reasons for their deletion must also be displayed at panchavat and block development offices, chayat and block development offices,

chayat and block development offices, the court directed.

"For a migrant worker who has been deleted as dead, even if he is illiterate, his neighbours or friends would alert him... it is only fair to have a procedure that does not block a person from exer-cising his right to adult franchise. There are civil consequences involved," Justice Kant told Senior Advagate Bakesh Duis-Kant told Senior Advocate Rakesh Dwivedi, who is appearing for the ECI.

Centre to ramp up urea supply

Union agriculture minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan chaired a meeting on Thursday where state agriculture ministers and offi-cials demanded additional urea supplies.

Chouhan asked states to take strict ac

cials demanded additional urea supplies.
Chouban saked states to take strict action against hoarders and black marketes,
adding that the Centre was already sending
enough supplies. He also urged states to accurtaely map the fertiliser requirement for
the upcoming rabi sowing season.

"There could be two main reasons for
the increased demand for urea: first, an increase in the sowing of rice, maize, and
other crops due to good rainfail; second,
possible misuse of urea for non-agricultural
purposes,"Chouhan said. He added that if
the demand was genuinely for farming
needs, urea would certainly be supplied.
But warned of strict action if there was any
suspicin on finisuse.

Chouhan urged all state agriculture
ministers to ensure optimum use of urea by
forming monitoring committees and
strengthening oversight mechanisms.

Chouhan said that the next rabi conference would be held on September 15 and
September 16 in New Delhi. On the first day
of the conference, the officials of the

counterparts will chalk out a road map and

The Meghalaya government has asked the Union Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) to convince Bangladesh for permission to erect border fencing closer to the international boundary to secure a 40 km unfenced stretch without leaving villages outside the fenced area, Deputy Chief Minister Prestone Tynsong said. Completely vague: SC on plea to return elephants kept in Vantara

The Supreme Court on Thursday termed as "completely vague" a plea seeking to constitute a monitoring committee to return the "captive elephants" in Vantara, a wildlife rescue and rehabilitation centre for wild animals. A bench of Justices Pankai Mithal and PB Varale told advocate CR Java Sukin. Pankaj Mithal and P B Varale told advocate C R. Jaya Sukin, petitioner in person, that he was making allegations against Vantara without even adding them as party. The top court asked the petitioner to implead Vantara in the petition. "You are making allegations against parties which are not represented here. You have not made them respondents. You implead them and then come back to us we will see, "the bench said and posted the matter for August 25. The apex court also tagged a similar petition with Sukin's plea.
